**MUAC interpretation of measurements for children from 6 to 59 months:**

Criteria	Normal	Moderate	Severe
<b>MUAC</b>	$\geq 125$	$\geq 115 \text{ and } < 125 \text{ mm}$	$< 115 \text{ mm}$

**Oedema Index**

Extent of oedema	Grade
feet/ankles	+
feet/ankles and legs	++
feet/ankles, legs and other parts of the body	+++

### 3. Criteria to determine acute malnutrition

Acute malnutrition	Criteria
Global Acute Malnutrition (SAM + MAM)	<-2 WHZ (0-59 months) and/or MUAC < 125 mm (6-59 months) and/or Bilateral oedema
Moderate Acute Malnutrition	<-2 to $\geq$ -3 WHZ (0-59 months) and/or MUAC $\geq$ 115 mm to < 125 mm (6-59 months)
Severe Acute Malnutrition	< -3 WHZ (0-59 months) and/or MUAC < 115 mm (6-59 months) and/or Bilateral oedema
