

Non-breast-fed infants: ensure a caregiver is identified and trained regarding the safe preparation of breast-milk substitutes (BMS)

Explanation regarding the nutrition status of the patient, explaining that the patients is not yet recovered of the malnutrition and has to continue the treatment

Exit ration (RUTF)

Discharge ration (Fortified Blended Flour and oil)

Explanation about the instructions on how to take the
RUTF

Ensure RUTF is given until the ATFC appointment

Information about the follow up visits at the ATFC and
when is the next appointment to the ATFC

Give vaccination card

Up to date vaccination status

For all type of discharges (cured, defaulter, transfer, death), patient records must be kept at the center discharging the child.

For infants 1-6 months explanation that the infant will not receive RUTF

Breastfed infants: explain that the infant will be fully recovered with the breastfeeding.

Explanation of the functioning of the ATFC
(frequency of the scheduled visits, activities done at the ATFC, weight, height, MUAC and oedema follow up, medical consultation, RUTF given, drugs and vaccination given...)
